What Is Post Employment Disclosure?

- HB 181 (125th General Assembly) Effective May 18, 2005
- Applicable to former State Elected Officers & Staff Members
- 24 Month Period
- Indicates whether or not filer will receive income from a qualifying source

Where Can I Find the Initial Post Employment Disclosure Statement?

- Go to www.jlec-olig.state.oh.us.
- From the Menu Bar click Ethics, select Post Employment Disclosure from the drop-down box, then click on PED Overview.
- Scroll down and select Initial PED Statement.

Who Files an Initial PED Statement?

- Financial Disclosure Statement Filers

- Who leave public service

JLEC 2010

What is Public Service?

- Employment at local, state or federal level
 - Includes:
 - Educational Service Centers
 - City Schools
 - State Agencies
 - Federal Agencies
- NOT required to File a PED

What is NOT considered public service?

- Institutions of Higher Education (RC §101.70 & JLEC Advisory Op. 97-001)
- State Retirement Systems

What is a Qualifying Source of Income? (1 of 3)

- An Executive Agency Lobbyist or Legislative Agent
 - Go to www.ohiolobbying.com and visit the Ohio Lobbying Activity Center for a list of registered agents

What is a Qualifying Source of Income? (2 of 3)

- Employer of an executive agency lobbyist or legislative agent, except an employer that is any state agency or political subdivision of the state
 - (visit the Ohio Lobbying Activity Center at www.ohiolobbying.com)

JLEC 2010

What is a Qualifying Source of Income? (3 of 3)

- Any entity, association, or business that, at any time during the two immediately preceding calendar years, was awarded one or more contracts by one or more state agencies that in the aggregate had a value of \$100,000 or more, or bid on one or more contracts to be awarded by one or more state agencies that in the aggregate had a value of \$100,000 or more
 - Visit the Controlling Board's website (www.ecb.ohio.gov) under 'Search Requests'
 - Contact new employer

Exception (Applies to Updated PED Statements only)

- Employed as a legislative agent, executive agency lobbyist, or retirement system lobbyist on behalf of the qualifying source of income
 - Not required to file Updated PED Statements – Must still file Initial PED Statement

What if the Employee does not have a Qualifying Source of Income?

- Under Section III – Identifying Qualifying Sources of Income
- **“If you will not receive income from any of the sources listed above please check here: _____ and proceed to Section IV.”**

Who is Responsible for Forwarding Initial PEDs to JLEC?

- The State Agency
 - By last date of public service
 - Forward to JLEC
